Tip for Phoenix NLME™ 1.0

Tip 3: How to reset plot attributes to display default formats.

It is common (and recommended) that the user make copies of earlier or 'base' Phoenix Models to build up to the final model. It is also expected that the user might want to edit graphical output to change markers, colors, size, etc. Once plots are edited, these edits are remembered by the Phoenix system and are available upon refresh when the object is copied or re-used. This is helpful to facilitate easy comparison across all graphical output. In some instances, however, the user might want to 'remove' the edits for plots for a particular Phoenix model and go back to the default settings. To accomplish this go to the **Plots tab** on the bottom of the object and **click the button 'Reset Existing Plots'**. After re-execution of the model all the plots will display the default formats. (Note: if future releases of Phoenix NLME add new default graphs or changes to the default plots, this option should also be selected to obtain the new plots).
